



## Tuition and Fees Full Time Students Rules and Regulations 2016-2017 School Year

Actual Cost per Student \$13,600

- Rates \$11,000, \$10,000, \$9,000, \$8,000
- Complete Income: 1040's, W-2's, and all schedules
- Mexican Annual Income Report
- No Income: Copy of SSI check
- Total family income information required to assess tuition.

Tuition for family with 2 or more children:

- Tuition cost \$5665 for each additional child.
- Additional student \$200 Annual Evaluation.

Tuition Assistance Eligibility:

- First come first serve basis and funds availability.
- All Parents must volunteer 20 hours per year to qualify for any assistance.
- All Parents must fulfill fundraising commitment per year.
- All Parents must meet financial guidelines.
- Completed grant application.
- No outstanding fees, tuition from previous year.
- Returning students must have good attendance, few tardies, exhibit good behavior, motivation and academic effort.

**Grant application will not be considered / reviewed if eligibility requirements are not met.**

Required:

- Signed contract
- Enrollment Forms
- Enrollment Fees: New Students \$450 Enrollment / Annual Evaluations, non-refundable
- Re-Enrollment Fees: Returning Students \$400, non-refundable
- Late fee: \$30 for payments received after the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month

Fundraiser:

- 2 per school year: per family @ \$500    1 per year per family @ \$200.00
